

FAVA'S: A TIMELESS CLASSIC

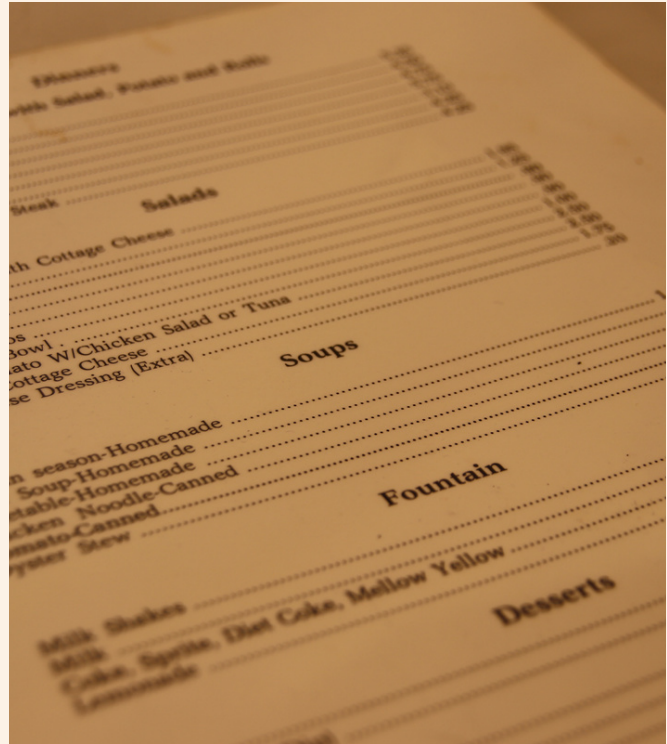


Beginning of Fava's - 1910

Giovani Luigi Carmelo Fava (Lui) and Assunta Maria Bertolini (Susie) emigrated separately from Italy in 1907 and 1908 respectively. Their two sponsors were friends and introduced the youngsters who later married. In 1910, Lui and Susie bought the building where Fava's is still located today and started a Confectionery shop where they had cases of candies, fruit, bits, and cheese, as well as homemade gelato!

Still Going Strong

Lui and Susie had two daughters, Natalina and Louise, who were born in 1919, shortly after Lui died as a result of the flu epidemic in 1918. Louise decided to take over running the Confectionery to keep the business going. She kept adding dishes until Fava's became a full functioning restaurant. Fava's has been passed down to many different people over the years and is noted as the only business on Main Street that's still in the same building and still doing the same business it started out doing!
