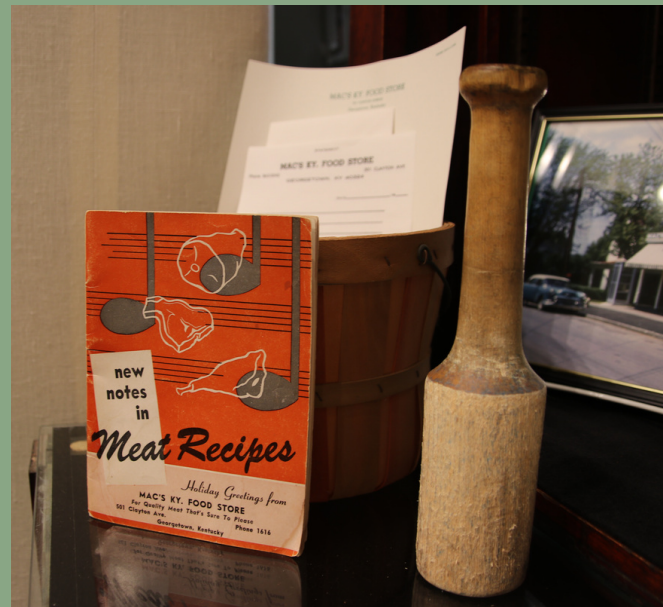

Warring Davis and Dorothy McFarland, better known as Mr. and Mrs. Mac, opened their business at 501 Clayton Avenue in July, 1950. Mac's was well known for selling top quality beef and homemade pimento cheese. In 1963, the family enlarged the building from two aisles to a "huge four aisle store".

## Slone's Foodtown

Slone's Foodtown was built in the mid 1960s, but had its beginnings in the Depression years of the 1930s. George and Virgie Slone borrowed money from a car dealership to save their farm in Ohio and came to Lexington to start a grocery business in order to repay the loan.

They started Slone and Slone grocery on Georgetown Street in Lexington. One of George and Virgie's sons, Virgil, became the one who stayed behind to run the store when the rest of the family returned to the Ohio farm after their debts were paid.

Virgil then decided to come to Georgetown to start Slone's Market at 130 North Broadway in 1937/1938. He then relocated to Indian Acres shopping center in early 1996.
